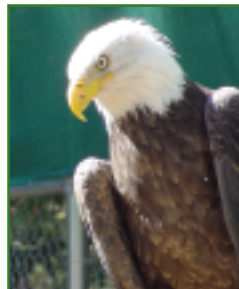
Community Outreach

(Program Length: 1-2 hours)

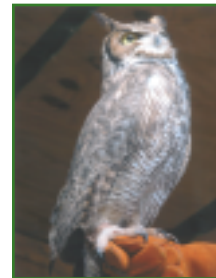
Best suited to groups of 40 or under, this informal program is designed for special meetings or group events where a variety of other activities are offered. Live birds of prey such as falcons, hawks, owls and eagles are seen "up close and personal."



"Wing to Wing" Presentation

(Program Length: 1 hour)

A more formal program adapted to both medium and large seated audiences. In this captivating participatory program, falcons, hawks, owls and eagles can be closely observed as handlers walk these magnificent raptors through the audience.

An "up close and personal" educational experience with indigenous mammals such as bear, bobcat, and raccoon.
